
English Slang Words Used On 2022 Tiktok Platform

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Abstract

This objective of the research were to find out the types of slang word that used on tiktok platform and to find out the positive impacts and negative impacts of the used of slang word on tiktok platform. The writer used qualitative descriptive method and used Allan and Burridge's theory to find out the types of slang word that use on tiktok platform. The positive and negative impacts of the used of slang words on the tiktok platform analyzed by the comment section of the videos. There are 5 types of the slang word used by content creator on tiktok platform, they are fresh and creative, flippant, imitative, acronym, and clipping. The result of this research shows fresh and creative is the most frequently used for english slang word. There are comments of tiktok users shows positive words and negative words. The result of data collected shows that tiktok users provide more positive impacts from comments than negative impacts.

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1. INTRODUCTION

Social beings, humans are unable to survive alone and people are social creatures. Humans use communication tools to interact with each other. Communication tools are used by people to communicate. Human communication is characterized by courteous and simple language. Saputra & Marlina (2019) stated that language is a tool that people use to communicate with one another.

The use of language is essential for interpersonal communication since without it, one could not interact with others. Sociolinguistics is a branch of linguistics. Holmes (2013) stated that sociolinguistics focused on analyzing the way people use language in different social contexts as well as the social relationships in a community, and how they convey and construct aspects of their social identity through their language.

Interaction between individuals and society resulted in many language varieties which caused language change. According to Mahboob (2014), the variations in language included its structures, grammatical features, and phonemic systems, in order to achieve diverse goals and purposes. There are some kinds of language variations one of those are slang language. According to dictionaries, slang is a very casual way of using words and expressions that is often more fun, elliptical, vivid, and fleeting than regular English. Furthermore, it's basically a language style that members of that particular group utilize. One such example is the internet. Generation Z nowadays is easily using social media to spread the message, causing a rapid development of slang (Rezeki et al., 2019). It could freely converse with person who speak different languages and accents on the internet. People today are inextricably linked to social media especially on tiktok platform. In this study, the researcher will be focusing on analyzing slang language that used on tiktok platform in 2022 until nowadays, from selected content creators on tiktok.

This objective of the research were to find out the types of slang word that used on tiktok platform and to find out the positive impacts and negative impacts of the used of slang word on tiktok platform.

2. LITERATURE REVIEW

This chapter consists of previous studies, approach, related ideas and theories. Related idea and theories consisted of the definition of linguistic, sociolinguistic and slang word.

2.1. Previous Studies

There are several previous researches which are similar to this study:

A Sociolinguistic Study Of Slang Words Used On Instagram. Awanda (2016). This research carried out a comparable research about Sociolinguistic. This study comes under the heading of qualitative research. The writer gathered the data by identifying slang terms in discussions and posts on Instagram accounts, and then they explained each word's meaning. The writer came across 47 slang terms. The writer discovered that 21 slang words had an English origin, 5 slang words had an Indonesian origin, 5 slang words had a Javanese origin, and 16 slang words had an unknown origin.

Morphological analysis of slang words found in Terminator 2: Judgment Day. Wirahadi et al. (2016) in the study's preceding chapter; as a result, certain conclusions are drawn from the discussions and the findings. Based on the slang analysis of the film Terminator 2: Judgment Day, there are find two kinds of slang, they are slang word and slang phrase. A few word forms from Guzman and O'Grady are included in the study. They are blending slang, clipping slang, compound slang, derivation slang, inflection slang and borrowing slang. Additionally, it is discovered that the movie's slang terms have both literal and figurative meanings. To determine the meaning of the slang utterances, the data are evaluated using the Oxford and Online Slang Dictionaries.

An Analysis Of Slang Words Used In Social Media. Trimastuti (2017). In their journal has examined the use of slang in Social media. This research is to acquire knowledge of slang terms (in this example, "Alay language"), which is complicated by the Indonesian language standard. The qualitative approach was used in this study, and the writer chose descriptive techniques to analyze the data. The information was gathered using BlackBerry Messenger, Twitter, Instagram, Route, Line, and Facebook. The writer used observation as a means of collecting data. The author discovered that in Alay language, "Alay" is a slang word used in teen conversations. The writer conclude that the essence of communication is transmission of meaning from one individual to another. Talk is the primary means by which people interact and satisfy personal and social goals. People interact primarily through talk, most often in informal conversation. "Alay" is one of slang language that used in talk between teenagers. It could be understood by certain group particularly group who use „alay“ language "Alay" language for communication has many errors in Bahasa Indonesia. Alay language in Social media could be minimized in order.

Harrated (2018) in their research *Slang Created And Used InIcak. Com Site: A Sociolinguistics Study.* This research investigated the slang created based on word formation processes as well as a its functions, and to describe the social factors influencing the existence of slang. The form of this research was qualitative method which resulted in descriptive data. The data was gathered by taking screenshots of memes or posts that had photographs that were

posted in succession. In this research, first, according to Yule, it has been discovered that several slang term generation processes and Yule theory. They are clipping, blending, borrowing, acronyms, initials, and derivation by adding with specific affixes (suffix). Second, In addition to what Coleman has said, it is discovered that slang language serves two other purposes; that there are 26 different contexts in why slang is used, including in praising and mocking. Variations in language are caused by Social and situational factors that affect how people use language. Furthermore, Irma et al. (2018) in their research *Slang Word Formation In Pitch Perfect Movie*, identified the type of slang that consists of the type of word formation. In this research, writer used content analysis design. Content analysis design is used to see the meaning and type that was stated in slang. In collecting the data, the writer used observational method by using non-participant observational technique. In analyzing data, the writer used identity method and it was followed by using equalizing technique. The result find there are four types of word formation type in slang that find in this film, they are compounding, back-formation, suffixation, and conversion.

An Analysis of Slang Language in "The Edge Of Seventeen" Movie; A Sociolinguistic Approach. Salamah (2018). This journal identified the slang terms used in the movie *The Edge of Seventeen* as well as the motivations behind the cast's use of them, The writer classified the many forms of slang language using Yule's (2006) theory, and the theory from (Partridge, 1954) to know the reasons of slang language. The writer employed the qualitative descriptive method in this study. The outcome of this research reveal that the type compounding is the most used in the movie, with amount of 14 out of 37 data, lowest types is back formation that find in this research, with amount of 1 out of 37 data, and the type blending is not find in this research study. In meanwhile, the majority of the movie's cast members use slang to convey their dissatisfaction and rage, and to convey that Someone is acting irrationally and the lowest reasons why the movie's cast members employ slang words, is to be secret, it means that not understood by those around one.

Saputra L et al. (2019) in their research *An Analysis Of Slang Words Used By Instagram Account Plesbol* focuses on finding the type and meaning of slang words that used in Pesbol instagram account. This study find that there are nine types of slang by Mattiello used in Instagram account Plesbol. They are acronym or initialism, blending, clipping, compounding, prefixation, reduplicative, reversed form, variation, and word manufacture and fanciful formation. Meanwhile the six others, there are suffixation, final combining forms, infixation, conversion, back-formation, and elliptic rhyming slang, are not find in Plesbol. From nine types of slang that have been find, compounding is the most used in Plesbol. Meanwhile, the least used in Plesbol is prefixation.

An Analysis Of Slang Words Used By BTS ARMY Community Conversation On Twitter. Fattaut (2020). This research find out the types of slang words by BTS ARMY Community on Twitter, and the function of using slang words by ARMY on Twitter. The theory were from Chapman (1988), and from Partridge (1979). This study shows that 50 utterances contains of slang languages. The first, the writer classified the types based on Chapman's (1988) theory which are primary slang and secondary slang. There are 9 primary slang words and 41 secondary slang words. Then, the writer analyzed the function of using slang words used by BTS ARMY Community on Twitter based theory on Partridge (1979) it is find only seven (7) function used by BTS ARMY Community on Twitter. So, that BTS ARMY Community considered slang

language as a new popular trend in their communication. They are created their own words and phrases only could be understood by their own groups to enrich the language in the Society.

Research written by Ulfah (2021) *Sociolinguistic Study Of Slang Words Used On Tiktok Memes Videos*, the writer used qualitative one to identify slang words to identify the dominant type of slang words and to find the functions of slang words used in short Memes videos on TikTok. This study aims to find out what types of slang words are used by TikTok users on making short Memes videos and the meaning of it. Thw researcher collects the data from TikTok with Ubuntu Linux operating system. Un-official TikTokApi was used as the instrument, it is legal to scrape data from websites for public consumption and use it for analysis. to concentrate on key characteristics slang contained, meme-relatedness, and popularity, and the findings of the research implied 33 slangs words found from various TikTok Videos posted by different users. Those are slang words that have been newly interpreted and invented slangs and have three functions according to Zhou and Fan (2013), they are, pursuit of self-identity, emotive feeling of slang words and achieving politeness.

Another research by Cecilika (2021), *An Analysis Of Slang Word In " Rush Hour" Movie: Sociolinguistics Approach*. This The researcher used purposive sampling research identified the various kinds and purposes of colloquialisms that are used in the movie Rush. Writers employed theories from Matiello (2008) and Allan & Burrige (2006) in this study. Because the writer made observations when collecting food data, this research used a qualitative descriptive method. Thirty-one pieces of information pertain to the many slang phrases that the characters in the movie Rush Hour use. 4 types of fresh and creative, 4 types of filippant, 12 types of imitative, 2 types of acronym and 9 types of clipping among them are. Additionally, 16 data on various purposes of the characters' employment of slang phrases in the rush hour movie were discovered by writers. Among them there are 4 functions of group and subject-restriction, 4 functions of informality and database, 1 function of playfulness and humor, 6 functions of freshness and novelty and 1 function of desire to impress and faddishness.

Nasution et al. (2021). *Slang Words in Me, and Earl, and The Dying Girl Novel: Type and Interpretation* were categorize types of slang words used in the novel and to explain the interpretations of them. The data were collected from the dialogues in the novel. Using qualitative approach, the writer used the theory of Chapman (1988) to classify the data into their types. To explain the interpretations of slang words, the writer analyzed the role relationship among the speakers, the way the actors speak, and the meaning of each slang word find using slang dictionaries. The analysis reveals that as the relationship among the actors are equal and they naturally raise within the community, actors in the novel dominantly use primary slang words. Conversation using secondary slang words take place when the actors are not engaged within the community.

The research written by Kasitha et al (2022). *An Analysis Of Compounding And Clipping Slang Words Found In "After We Collided" Movie*. This research categorize and examine various slang terms of compounding and clipping types of slang words that used in After We Collided movie. Yule's (1986) theory that applied to identify the categories of compounding and clipping. Using Leech's (1981) theory, the meaning of slang terms in the film is examined. In this study, the descriptive qualitative method applied. The result find eleven data were discovered as compounding, and seven data were discovered as clipping. With the percentage, compounding 39% and clipping 61%. Six data are categorized according to their conceptual

meaning, One piece of data find to have connotative meaning, one data as affective meaning, and eleven data sets classified in social meaning. With the percentages social meaning 34%, connotative meaning 5%, social meaning 61%, and affective meaning 5%.

Sari (2023). *Slang Word Types In Two Famous English Songs Of Blackpink*. This research indicated that three categories of slang terms were identified, including Debasement with two data, Group-and subject-restriction with 22 data, and Secrecy and Privacy with 47 data. In conclusion, we could see that secrecy and privacy are the most frequently used slang terms in the two well-known English Songs by Blackpink, "Ice Cream" and "Bet You Wanna". The data is analyzed using the theory of slang words relating to speaker-oriented social features supported by Mattiello (2008).

Research study was done by Mulyantini et al. (2023). *Analysis on The Types of English Slang Words Found in Neel+ Jordan Podcast*, categorize the slang terms that Neel and Jordan used in their podcast chat. The data are collected from their podcast on Youtube named Australian Culture. The purpose of this study was to facilitate podcast listeners' comprehension of the information. There is a descriptive qualitative approach used. The information is gathered through note-taking and observational methods. These are the five categories of slang: fresh & creative, clipping, flippant, acronym, and imitative based on the theory used from Allan & Burrige (2006). To ensure that the analysis was understandable to the readers and that the data was organized using a table, the writer conducted a description after gathering the data. The study's findings indicated that the Neel + Jordan Podcast had five different kinds of slang.

Another research was written by Oktaviani et al. (2023). *Slangs Used in The Movie "Lady Bird"*, identify the kinds and definitions of slang terms used in the Lady Bird film. In this study, the writers investigated the Sorts of slang phrases based on the idea from Allan and Burrige (2006). Allan and Burrige divided slang words into five categories: fresh and creative, flippant, imitative, acronym, and clipping. This study employed a qualitative research methodology. Considering the outcome, there were 33 slang terms discovered, 21 slangs were categorized as fresh and creative, 9 slang words were categorized as flippant, and 3 slang words were categorized as imitative.

Christian et al (2023). *An Analysis on Slang Words in 8 Mile Movie: A Sociolinguistics Study*. This research examine the forms and uses of slang terms as they relate to Sociolinguistics in the film 8 Mile. The theory of Wardhaugh (1986) and Alan & Burrige (2006) used in this study. Categorizing slang words into five categories and defining the function into three function of slang words. The research methodology employed for data collection and analysis was the descriptive qualitative approach, utilizing techniques for documentation and observation. The study's analytical results are comprise; the first of which is the types of slang words find consisting of fresh and creative slang words, clipping slang words, acronym slang words, flippant slang words, and imitative slang words. The second is function of slang words that find is consist of slang to initiate a conversation, term used to address person, slang to humiliate person. It may be inferred that the most common Sort of slang is clipping and function used to humiliate a person.

Based on the previous study above, this research has both similarities and distinctions. Regarding the similarities, slang words were covered in the earlier studies and this research. Nevertheless, the research object differs. In this research the writer will analyze slang word on tiktok in 2022 used by creators.

2.2 Sociolinguistics

Blommaert, J. (2005) stated that sociolinguistics could be defined by two angles of simplicity and complexity. Simply speaking, the main content of Sociolinguistics is the study of the relationship between language and Society. Specifically, the main content of Sociolinguistics is the study of language structure and social context. Through the study of the interaction and influence between them, sociolinguists try to analyze from the various social cultural phenomena and explore different discourse behaviours. The scope of Sociolinguistics studies, in general, is defined according to the relationship between language and society.

According to Nisa (2019) sociolinguistic is the branch of linguistics that studies language in relation to Society. Society and language go together like hand and glove. They are inextricably linked because language could not exist without Society. Sociolinguistics has a great deal to say about the nature of Society and language. In different social context we have distinct speech patterns. Sociolinguistics is the study of the interaction between language and society.

According to Silaban et al. (2020) sociolinguistic is the study or discussion of language in use is known as Sociolinguistics; its goal is to demonstrate how language usage conventions are related to other aspects of culture. As a the outcome, sociolinguistics is the study of language and the relation to social conditions (studies by social science especially Sociology), The study of the relationship between language and the situational relationships in which it is employed is known as sociolinguistics.

Sociopragmatics is combination of two science disciplines, between Sociolinguistics and pragmatics. Leech (2014) stated that Sociopragmatics is the meeting point of the two disciplines of Sociolinguistics and pragmatics. Sociopragmatics use pragmatics science to investigate linguistic meaning used in communication in certain social conditions of Society. Leech (2014) also added that Sociopragmatics studies explain in more detail local conditions regarding the used of language, or it could be explain that Sociopragmatics studies focuses the use of a particular language on a social context. Sociopragmatics is related to use of language prevailing in Society.

2.3 Slang Word

Slang is a term, phrase, or expression that young people in their society frequently use. It used unusual vocabulary. Therefore, the use of slang word in a formal setting is not appropriate as in the school, university, or in the office.

According to Allan & Burrige (2006), there are five types of slang namely fresh and creative, flippant, imitative, acronym, and clipping.

Fresh and Creative

This type shows that slang word has different vocabulary to describe something in casual setting. Many things that already common in our subconscious may be slang words that we did not know.

Flippant

This form shows that slang is formed from two or more terms whose written terms did not refer to denotative meanings.

Imitative

It means that the slang word comes from a Standard English word; use Standard English word in different meanings or combine two different words.

Acronym

It is constructed by the result of a word formed by the first letter of each word in a phrase or created by the initials of a group of words or syllables and pronounced them as a new word.

Clipping

This type means that a slang word is created by removing some parts of a longer word into a shorter form in the same sense.

2.4 Tiktok Application

TikTok is one of the most widely utilized Social media platforms currently. Tiktok Platform was released worldwide in 2017, consists of a mobile short-form videos that users perform lip-syncs or other creative music videos. According to Xiuwen et al (2021) argued that TikTok is a popular Social media Software that allows users to make, watch, and share short films up to three minutes long on their smartphones. According to Weimann et al. (2020) TikTok is the fastest growing app on the market today, with hundreds of millions of users, the most of which are youngsters and teenagers, using it to upload, show, and navigate lip sync videos and Memes.

3. METHOD

The researcher analyzed the data used descriptive qualitative method. The analyzed by applying the theory of Allan and Burridge to find out the types of slang word such as fresh and creative, flippant, imitative, acronym, clipping that used on the video by selected content creators and describe the impact of the used of slang word. The negative and positive impacts of the used of slang words in the Tiktok platform analyzed by the comment section of the videos.

4. RESULTS

4.1 Types of Slang Word Creators Used on the Tiktok Platform

There were 5 types of slang word that used on Tiktok Platform 2022 by selected creators content. There were *fresh and creative, flippant, imitative, acronym, and clipping*.

Fresh and Creative

This type shows that slang word has different vocabulary to describe something in casual setting. Many things that already common in the subconscious may be slang words that people do not know.

Ghost

"He ghosted me after our first date, i didn't know what happened."

"She is been ghosting us all week. I hope everything is okay."

Slang word *ghost* represented the word *ghost* that have different meaning vocabulary to describe *ghost* in casual setting.

Lit

"Harry Style's concert outfit was lit. I loved it"

"Have a lit Monday!"

Lit used to refer to the light, but when it came to slang the word *lit* had different meaning and vocabulary.

Flippant

This form showed that slang was formed from two or more terms whose written terms did not refer to denotative meaning.

No cap

“Hey y’all, guess what I heard, man? I heard about the thunderstorm in about an hour. Nah, no cap.”

No cap referred to confirm something was true. Based on the data above, this slang word categorized as *flippant*

Throwing Shade

“Yo, stop throwing shade”

This slang words *throwing shade* formed from two or more terms whose written terms did not refer to denotative meaning.

Spill The Tea

“Come on spill the tea”

This data was formed by three words. *This* sentences refer to tell the hidden truth or to tell the gossips. speaker wanted the listener to told the gossip or the latest news.

Imitative

Imitative means that the slang word came from a Standard English word; the use of Standard English word in different meanings or combine two different words.

Wongo

“Wongo da the park later?.”

“Wongo da the movies?”

Wongo was combined by 5 different word. The word *wongo* has the same meaning as the formal form *Do you want to go to*.

Acronym

Acronym was constructed by the result of a word formed by the first letter of each word in a phrase or created by the initials of a group of words or syllables and pronounced them as a new word.

GOAT

“You are the GOAT of dancing.”

“Lebron James is the GOAT of Basketball.”

The word “GOAT” was constructed by the result of a word formed by the first letter of each word in a phrase.

G.W.R.M

“Lets’s GWRM”

This slang *GWRM* is slang word that constructed by the result of a word formed by the first letter of each word in a phrase or created by the initials of a group of words or syllables and pronounced them as a new word.

Clipping

Clipping was type that had meaning that a slang word was created by removing some parts of a longer word into a shorter form in the same sense.

Delulu

“People are just delulu and I am just delulu”

This slang word *delulu* categorized as *clipping* type. The word “Delulu” can be classified

as *clipping*.

Sus

"This is quite sus"

"The toilet smells like vomit. But you know what the most sus thing? The toilet wasn't that dirty. There are no sign of vomit".

This slang word represented type of *clipping*. The word of *sus* was a word that created by removing some part of a longer word into a shorter form from Suspicious to "*Sus*". The sentence "*This is quite sus*" it showed expression that there was something untrustworthy or questionable. "*The toilet smells like vomit. But you know what the most sus thing? The toilet wasn't that dirty. There are no sign of vomit*". Intention of this sentence there was something untrustworthy or questionable about the condition of the toilet.

4.2 The Positive Impacts and Negative Impacts of The Used of Slang Words On The Tiktok Platform

Positive Impact

"I'm a millennial but I'm on tiktok so I know it"

The user wrote "I am millennial but I am on tiktok so I now it". The user was millennial but she knew the slang word that created on tiktok, while the slang word created mostly by generation z. It showed on comment that the user interested.

"I love it. I do not know what any of that means, but my boys used to talk like this sometimes. That is a spot on impersonation."

The user wrote, "*I love it. I did not know what any of that means, but my boys used to talk like this sometimes*". The user did not understand the meaning of the slang word that used on tiktok but the user love it. According to oxford dictionary, definition of love, it was a very strong feeling of liking and caring for somebody or something. It could be concluded that the user had strong feeling of liking the used of slang word fo tiktok platform.

Negative Impact

"I am technically a gen z but I feel like a millennial cause I don not understand all slang".

The tiktok user wrote that "*I am technically a gen z but i feel like a millennial cause i did not understand all the slang.*" The user mentioned that did not understand the used of slang on Tiktok platform nowadays. From the comment above it showed the user had no interested to use the slang word. That mean the user did not followed the trend.

"I am gen z and I feel disconnected to gen z slang"

The tiktok user gave negative response. The tiktok user wrote that the tiktok user were gen z but felt disconnected. From that confession, it showed the user did not understand how people on tiktok used slang word and the user did not followed the trend. Therefore, the user did not understand the used of slang word that used nowadays.

Based on the data above, there are 5 types of slang word that used on tiktok fresh and creative, flippant, imitative, acronym, and clipping. Positive impacts that users were entertained and interested by the presence of the new slang word on tiktok platform and the user indirectly learned about the new slang word on tiktok. The negative impact of slang word that used on tiktok and make the users can not understand the meaning of the video

5. DISCUSSION

In this section, the researcher described in detail the results find at the findings stage based

on the type of slang words.

5.1 Types

5.2 Types of Slang Word Creators Used on the Tiktok Platform

The researcher categorized the slang words based on Allan and Burridge (2006). The first type is fresh and creative, ghost represented ignoring someone and lit represented great. The literal meaning of ghost based on the oxford dictionary was an apparition of a dead person which was believed to appeared. The meaning of ghost in the sentences above were referred to ignoring someone or someone acting like not there. This slang word referred to the conotation of a word that depends on cultural context and personal associations and this word more referred to said something was the great or stunning. This word used to expressed something was very bright, light, great in a casual way. These two slang words are created to say something in casual way as it explained based on Allan and Burridge theory.

Second type of slang word is flippant with slang word no cap, throwing shade, and spill the tea. No cap is slang word that formed from two terms and did not refer to denotative meanings. In oxford dictionary had mentioned the meaning of no and cap. No was not and cap was a kind of soft, flat hat, typically with a peak. Intention of the sentence was the speaker told something true about the thunderstorm without lying at all. Second data is throwing shade that refer to insult or criticize someone indirectly. Based on the literal meaning of throwing and shade from oxford dictionary, throwing was propel something with force through the air by a movement of the arm and hand; while shade was comparative darkness. In this sentence throwing shade was referred to insult or criticize someone indirectly and out of the true meaning of the words. The third data slang word is spill the tea, this slang word refer to told the gossip. This data was formed by three words. In oxford dictionary mentioned the meaning of spill was cause or allow (liquid) to flow over the edge of it is container, especially unintentionally; while the tea was a hot drink made by infusing the dried crushed leaves of the tea plant in boiling water. But this data have different meaning from it is literal meaning. Spill the tea in this sentences refer to tell the hidden truth or to tell the gossips. These slang are created by social group with conotative meaning to say something in different way as it explained based on Allan and Burridge theory.

The third type is imitative with slang word wongo, this slang word is the abbreviation from combining 5 words. The word wongo has the same meaning as the formal form Do you want to go to. It is usually used by the English people in their daily communication. Based on Allan and Burridge theory this slang categorized as type of Imitative.

The fourth types is acronym with slang GOAT and GWRM. This abbreviation GWRM formed from Get Ready With Me that refer tell people to accompany the speaker prepared before went out. GOAT is slang words that constructed by the first letter of each word. GOAT constructed by Greatest Of All Time that meaning The best of the best. Based on Allan And Burridge GWRM and GOAT type of acronym because it constructed by the first letter of the word.

The last type is clipping with slang word delulu and slang word sus. Based on Allan and Burridge theory, clipping is the type of slang word that have meaning that a slang word was created by removing some parts of a longer word into a shorter form in the same sense. Slang word delulu is shorten from delusional and slang word sus is shorten from suspicious.

Based on Allan and Burridge theory, these two slang words are created by removing some parts of a longer word into a shorter but still have the same meaning from the literal meaning. From 5 types of slang words, it find that fresh and creative is the most frequently used for english slang word 2022 until 2024.

On the previous studies has mentioned another research that also discuss about slang word. But the research that mentioned have different object to identify with different theory to analysis the data. Research by Awanda (2016) identifying slang terms and posts on Instagram accounts, and then they explained each word's meaning. The writer discovered that 21 slang words had an English origin, 5 slang word had an Indonesian origin, 5 slang words had a Javanese origin, and 16 slang words had an unknown origin. Wirahadi et al. (2016) focuss on analysing the used of slang word on movie. There are find two kinds of slang that find on this research, they are slang word and slang phrase. While on this research focuss on analysing types of slang words and the positive and negative impacts.

Harrated (2018) investigated the slang created based on word formation processes as well as a its functions, and to describe the social factors influencing the existence of slang by using theory of Yule and theory of Chapman. Harrated (2018) and discovered that several slang term generation processes and Yule theory. They are clipping, blending, borrowing, acronyms, initials, and derivation by adding with specific affixes (suffix). Second, In addition to what Coleman has said, it is discovered that slang language serves two other purposes; that there are 26 different contexts in why slang is used, including in praising and mocking. From the research mentioned, can conclude that it have different theory and different object with this research the used of slang word on 2022 tiktok platfom that find 5 types of slang word by using theory of Allan & Burridge (2006) and positive and negative impacts by using the slang word from comment section on tiktok platform and find that the positive impatcs more dominant.

Research that also identified slang word on Tiktok by Ulfah (2021) analysing tiktok memes video, only focus on identify the dominant type of slang words and find the functions of slang words used in short Memes videos on TikTok. Research from Ulfah (2021) also used qualitative method to identify the slang. But, the data collected on this research taken from TikTok with Ubuntu Linux operating system. Research from Ulfah (2021) used Zhou & Fan (2013) to identify the function of the used of slang word. The findings of the research implied 33 slangs words found from various TikTok Videos posted by different users. While in this research focuss on analysing types on tiktok slang word from 5 selected creators and find 5 types of slang word fresh and creative, flippant, imitative, acronym, and clipping.

Nasution et al. (2021) research focuss on categorize types of slang words used in the novel, the writer used the theory of Chapman (1988) to classify the data into their types the result find that as the relationship among the actors are equal and they naturally raise within the community, actors in the novel dominantly use primary slang words and conversation using secondary slang words take place when the actors are not engaged within the community. Besides, Sari (2023) focuss to analyzed song ice cream and bet you wanna from blackpink using the theory of slang words relating to speaker-oriented social features by Mattiello (2008), the result find three categories of slang terms were identified, including Debasement with two data, Group-and subject-restriction with 22 data, and Secrecy and Privacy with 47 data. Studies by Nasution (2021) and Sari (2023) have different object with this research, they are focuss to identify the used of slang word in novel and analysing the slang word on blackpink song.

The studies that mentioned above have different object with this research that focuss on analysing types of slang words and the positive and negative impacts. This research found 5 types of slang word fresh and creative, flippant, imitative, acronym, and clipping and find that people indirectly can learn about slang words from the used of slang word on tiktok platform, but besides there are some people can not understand and confuse by the used of slang word on tiktok platform.

5.3 The Positive Impacts and Negative Impacts of the Used of Slang Words on Tiktok Platform

The use of the slang word have positive and negative impacts for the people using it. The writer take data from the comment section that can shows public responses about the used of slang word on tiktok platform nowadays.

On the tiktok platform shows that several of the user followed the trend about the used of slang word on tiktok platform. But several of the users are do not understand and confuse by the used of slang word. From data collected it shows that the users on tiktok platform are enjoying the trend and indirectly the users on tiktok platform learn about English. The user also indirectly familiar with the slang word that used on tiktok. The users gave response that slang word on tiktok are interesting and the user are entertained. It catched people's attention and want to discover more about new slang word. With the new slang word that appear on tiktok, the user realized that language changed in time. The user that give positive responses shows that they enjoy and joining the trend. The negative impacts of using the slang word on tiktok platform shows that the users could not understood the creator's videos. It could created negative impact. The user confused and totally do not know about the meaning and the used of slang word that appeared on tiktok platform. The user mention that need someone to translate the slang word that used on tiktok. It could be concluded that the user confused and totally did not know about the meaning. This condition make the user hate slang word.

6. CONCLUSIONS

There are 5 types of slang word used on tiktok paltform, *fresh and creative*, *flippant*, *imitative*, *acronym*, and *clipping*. The most popular types is *fresh and creative*. The positive impacts in using slang word on tiktok platform find that the users have interest of this trend and followed the trend and indirectly the users on tiktok platform learn about English, while the negative impacts several user confuse and can not understand the meaning of the video content.

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
